WHEN: Friday, May 14, 2010 at 6 pm to Saturday, May 15, 2010 at 10 am

WHERE: Okanogan High School, Okanogan, Washington

WHAT: Try to imagine a giant moving slumber party with 500 or more guests. Teams of 8-15 walkers from businesses, churches, schools, organizations, families and neighborhoods join with our honored guests-cancer survivors, and their families.

In the Opening Ceremony of **Relay For Life**, cancer survivors and their care-givers walk the first lap. The team participants then start their rotations for the rest of the event. After dark, luminary bags are lit honoring survivors, those battling cancer and in memory of those who have lost their lives to the disease. The candles stay lit throughout the night, motivating the walkers through their paces. Entertainment, activities and kid's activities, colorful decorated tents; prizes, games and fun for all ages round out the **Relay** experience.

HOW: **Team Registration: \$150 - includes fifteen T-shirts**

One member of each team should be on the track throughout the event, whether walking, running, wheel chairing, or sitting in a lawn chair on the track. Each team participant is also asked to raise a minimum of \$100 in donations (not pledges for laps). The most successful fundraisers exceed this amount by sending donation requests to friends and relatives and a variety of team fundraising events.
